

Aleph Beis Sand Art

 20 Minutes



Instructions:

Use the picture of the finished art, as a guide to know which color sand should be used for each area of the craft.

1. Pull off one sticker, and then gently sprinkle the right colored sand evenly over that area.
2. Once the area is evenly covered, pour any excess sand back into its bag. Remember to make sure the area is completely covered in colored sand, before moving onto the next sticker.
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2, for each sticker on your craft until your whole board is colored with beautiful colors of sand.
