Pasta Art Part 2



ART OPTION 1: PASTA NECKLACE

AGES 4-6 | ⌚ 15 MINUTES

Instructions:

1. Ask an adult to help tie one piece of colored pasta onto the end of the yarn, this will stop the pasta from slipping off.
2. Thread the colored pasta onto the yarn. You can choose to use a random order or make a pattern.
3. When your string is full of pasta, ask an adult to help un-tie that first piece of pasta, and knot both ends of the yarn together. Now your beautiful pasta necklace is ready for you to wear!



ART OPTION 2: PASTA MOSAIC ART

AGES 7-12 | ⌚ 15 MINUTES

Instructions:

4. Cut the white cardstock into whatever size and shape you'd like your mosaic to be.
Ex: square, circle, triangle, rectangle
5. Trace your white cardstock shape onto the cardboard and cut it out to be the same size.
6. Glue the white cardstock onto the cardboard, this will give your mosaic piece a strong backing.
7. Arrange your colored pasta pieces out from the center, and feel free to play around with them before you glue them down.

Tip: Pour some glue onto a plate and use a wooden skewer or q-tip to dab small amounts of glue at a time to make your mosaic much neater.

- Dried pasta: variety of shapes and sizes
- White cardstock
- Cardboard
- Scissor
- Liquid glue
