# Fizzy Sidewalk Chalk

## ② 20 Minutes



## Instructions:

- 1. Set up this activity outside on the pavement.
- 2. Mix ½ cup baking soda and ½ cup cornstarch into each bottle or container.
- **3.** Pour in enough water to cover the baking soda and cornstarch mixture in each bottle and stir until smooth.
- **4.** Add food coloring to each container and mix it up. Have fun playing with the colors, mix and match to make new colors.

**Tip:** Red and blue make purple. Yellow and blue make green. Yellow and red make orange.

- **5.** Allow the fun to begin! Make shapes, draw lines, and make designs on the pavement with the homemade sidewalk chalk paint you just created.
- **6.** Fill a bottle full of vinegar. Once you've created a design, pour the vinegar over it and watch it fizz!
- **7.** Repeat with different designs- try to make one that connects to something you learned in camp this week!

- Baking soda (2 Cups)
- Cornstarch (2 Cups)
- Water
- Spoon
