

Torah Circuit

② 20 Minutes



Instructions:

- **1.** Fold each sheet of paper in half and place a paper clip at the bottom. Place the sheets of paper next to each other on a tray.
- 2. Using the glue "Draw" over the Torah outline from the paper clip up the paper and then towards the edge. Be generous with the glue.
- **3.** Sprinkle a good layer of salt on the glue. Lift the paper and dump the extra salt on the tray. Tilt the tray to move the salt to the side.
- **4.** Take the exposed red wire from the battery pack and wrap it around one of the paper clips. Secure in place with electrical tape. Make sure the wire and paper clip make good contact.
- **5.** Repeat with the black wire, attaching it to the other paper clip and securing the connection with electrical tape.
- **6.** Add watercolors to the salty glue lines using a pipette or the tip of a paintbrush. It will flow along the salt and glue drawing.
- 7. Now, we're going to turn this into an electrical circuit! Bend the legs of the LED out. Touch the long leg (positive side) of the LED to the glue/salt line attached to the red wire.

4. The light colors will show through where you scrape away the black!

Picture Perfect Torah

Instructions:

- 1. Peel off one sticker section on the Torah card.
- **2.** With the NON shiny side facing DOWN, place the foil paper over the sticky part.
- **3.** Rub over it with your finger.
- **4.** Remove the foil paper and you will see that the shiny foil stays stuck down.
- **5.** Continue the above steps peeling one sticky part a time until you have a beautiful shiny Torah foil art!
- **6.** You can choose to frame your art or hang it as is!

Rainbow Popsicles

(1) 25 Minutes



Instructions:

- **1.** Whisk together the pudding mix and soy milk, until smooth. If it is too thick add a little more soy milk.
- 2. Divide pudding equally into 5 bowls.
- **3.** Add 6 drops of food coloring into each bowl to make red, orange (1 drop red, 5 drops yellow), yellow, green and blue pudding. Stir each color until mixed.
- **4.** Using a small spoon, add approximately 1 tablespoon of red pudding to the bottom of the Dixie cup. Tap the cup gently on the counter to even out the layer.
- **5.** Continue adding approximately 1 tablespoon of orange, yellow, green then blue pudding layers and tapping them gently between each layer to even them out.
- **6.** Add a small square of tin foil to the top of each Dixie cup.
- 7. Use a knife to poke a hole in the middle of the tin foil on each cup. Then poke the popsicle sticks through the hole in the foil and push to the bottom.
- **8.** Freeze for 6 hours or until completely frozen.
- **9.** When ready rip the paper cup off and ENJOY!

Craft Corner

Watercolor Magnets

20 Minutes


Instructions:

- **1.** Paint your paper with a few spots of water, about the size of your beads.
 - (Wetting the paper first will help blend the colors together and help give a geode look.)
- 2. Add a few small drops of different colored watercolors to each spot of water.
- **3.** Delicately swirl the colors, but be careful not to over mix the colors.
- **4.** While it's still wet, sprinkle on some salt, it leaves great texture.



- **5.** After the paint fully dries lightly rub the salt off.
- **6.** Using a pencil, trace a flat glass bead around each spot of color on your paper.

Optional: Add some details with a colorful gel pens for a little extra sparkle.



7. Paint mod podge on the flat side of your beads and tightly press them on top of each traced spot of color.



- **8.** Wait for the mod podge to dry.
- 9. Cut around each glass bead and add a magnet to the flat back of it with glue.
- 10. When the glue dries, place your magnet on the fridge or your locker!

Water Slides

20 Minutes



Instructions:

- Your task is to build a working water slide that will transport a toy figure down the slide- without leaking water.
- 2. Here are instructions to build the water slide but you can also choose to be creative and make your own version.
- 3. Make the slide:



- Cut a paper tube in half lengthwise.
- Add a line of glue down the inside center of each half tube.
- Cut a piece of plastic wrap or aluminum foil large enough to cover each half tube and attach it to the glue at its center.
- Continue wrapping the half tubes all around the back, sides and ends, and secure with tape.
- Attach the tubes together by placing one tube slightly inside of the second tube. Secure with tape on the backside of the tubes.

OVERVIEW

Design and build a water slide that can transport cargo down it!

- Paper Tube (1 big or 2 small)
- Plastic Wrap or aluminum foil
- Paper Straws (4)
- Paper Cups (3)
- Glue
- Tape
- Bowl
- Water
- Mini toy figure

Water Slides Continued

4. Build the support structure:



- Stack the openings of 2 cups and tape them together.
- Insert 2 straws inside the top of the taped cups to form a V shape. Poke holes to insert the straws and tape them in to keep it secure.
- Take another cup and turn it upside down.
- Insert 2 straws inside the top of the upside down cup to form a V shape. Poke holes to insert the straws and tape them in to keep it secure.

5. Put the slide together:



- Take the water proofed tube and lean it on top of the cupstraw structure.
- Place a bowl at the bottom of the slide to catch the water.

6. Practice!

- Pour water from the top of the slide and watch it slide down to the bottom, check that the bowl is placed in a way that it catches the water.
- Add a mini toy figure to the top of the slide and pour water onto the slide to see if it can transport the cargo down the slide!
- **7.** Here are some other ideas to add to your slide:
 - Make a ladder or ramp that reaches to the top of the slide.
 - Make a curve in the slide and adjust the support structure to keep it in a position for the water to flow down.
 - Get creative and use your imagination!



Disappearing Picture Experiment

15 Minutes

Instructions:

1. Put the picture into the bag and use the sharpie to trace the picture on the bag.



2. Take the picture out and color it in.



3. Place the picture back into the bag and close the bag.

4. Dip the bag into the water and look down from on top into the cup. The color from your picture will disappear.



What's Happening? Water refraction causes us to only see what's written on the ziplock bag when it is in the water. As soon as you pull the bag out of the water, we can see what is on the paper as well.

Craft Corner

Pinwheel

② 20 Minutes

Instructions:

- If using blank paper, begin by decorating it markers, crayons or colored pencils.
- 2. Use a ruler and pencil to draw light lines from each corner of the squares to create 4 triangles.



3. Cut on each of these lines almost to the center. Leave about ¼" uncut before the center cross mark.



4. Carefully place a small amount of glue in the center of the paper. Bring one corner of the diagonal line to the center of the paper and hold in place until the glue keeps it there.



5. Continue, bringing in each triangle to the center and attaching it with glue to every other point. After bringing it corner to corner, set aside to dry completely.



6. Once the glue is dry, ask an adult to help you press a thumb tack into the center of the pinwheel. Press this into the unsharpened pencil eraser and enjoy!





OVERVIEW

Make your own pinwheel and watch it spin!

- Paper (cut into a 6"x6" square), this can be decorative or plain paper
- Scissor
- Pencil (for tracing)
- Ruler
- Glue
- Pencil with eraser (unsharpened)

Roll a Landscape

20 Minutes



Instructions:

- 1. Roll a dice.
- **2.** Find the corresponding number on your printed Roll-a-Landscape card.
- 3. Go down the column to find what item to add to your drawing. Ex: if it's your first turn, go down one row, if it's your 2nd turn go down 2 rows...
- **4.** Draw the item on your paper. You want to have a full picture landscape when you're finished the game, so take your time and add in each part to have a complete picture at the end.
- 5. Continue this process until you have a complete landscape!
- **6.** You can make 36 different landscapes with this drawing game, so you can play this over and over again and never get the same landscape twice. Have fun!

DIY Bookmark

(1) 25 Minutes

Instructions:

1. Wrap yarn about 50 times around the piece of cardboard, then cut off the excess yarn.



2. Slide a piece of yarn under all the yarn wrapped around the cardboard, then double knot it at the top.



- 3. Cut all the yarn on the opposite side and keep all the yarn folded as is.
- **4.** Tightly double knot a piece of yarn near the top to make the head of the tassel.
- **5.** Tightly double knot a piece of yarn underneath the previous piece of yarn.
- 6. Cut off all excess yarn and scraggly ends. Your yarn tassel should look like this!



7. Fold the cardstock in half lengthwise



OVERVIEW

Make your own personalized bookmark to keep your place in your Torah books!

- A ball of yarn in color of voice
- Piece of cardboard about 3.5 inches wide
- Scissors
- Piece of cardstock paper 4.5 inches wide by 6.5 inches long
- Decorating supplies such as markers, crayons, ribbons, stickers
- Hole puncher
- Glue

DIY Bookmark Continued

- 8. Apply a thin layer of Mod Podge with a foam brush on the inside of the cardstock, then fold it back and let it dry.
- **9.** Decorate your bookmark however you like!
- **10.** Punch a hole at the top of the bookmark.



11. Double knot the tassel through the hole and cut off the excess yarn.



Craft Corner

Popsicle Stick Picture Frame

20 Minutes

Instructions:

- **1.** Protect your work area with newspaper.
- **2.** Begin by making the backing for the frame.
 - Place 12 popsicle sticks down next to each other lengthwise.
 - Spread glue across two popsicle sticks and place one across the top of your row of popsicle sticks, and the other across the bottom.
 - Wait until dry.



- 3. Once the backing is dry, flip it over and place your photo in the center of the frame backing. (Do not glue the photo down yet, it will wrinkle.)
- 4. Spread glue across two popsicle sticks and place one down across the top of your photo, so that it is glued onto both the photo and the popsicle stick background. Place the other popsicle stick down across

the bottom of your photo, again so that it is glued onto the photo and the background. (This will hold your photo in place.)



5. Put glue on the ends of the popsicle sticks you just glued down. Place two popsicle sticks so that they connect the top and bottom popsicle sticks and form a frame around the photo.



- 6. Let dry.
- Decorate your frame with glitter glue, gems and any other fun craft supplies you want. Wait until these dry.
- **8.** Attach a ribbon or string to the back of your frame to allow it to hang easily.
- **9.** When the frame is completely dry, hang it up in a special place!

- Wood Craft Sticks (colored or regular)

Water Gun Race Track

15 Minutes



Instructions:

- **1.** Do this activity outdoors.
- **2.** Punch a hole into the bottom of a cup with a pen. It should be close to the edge.
- **3.** Create your race track. Choose 2 points outside that the string can attach to. They should be at least 8 feet apart from each other. It could be a wall, tree, chair or doorknob etc.
- **4.** Thread the string through the whole on the bottom of the cup.
- **5.** Tape one end of the string to one of your chosen points and the other end to your other chosen point.
- **6.** Fill your water gun or other squirting toy with weather and use it to get the cup to move from one end of string to the other.
- 7. Set a timer and challenge yourself. How long does it take to get from start to finish of your race track?
- **8. Optional:** Set up 2 strings and cups to race with a sibling, friend or parent!


