

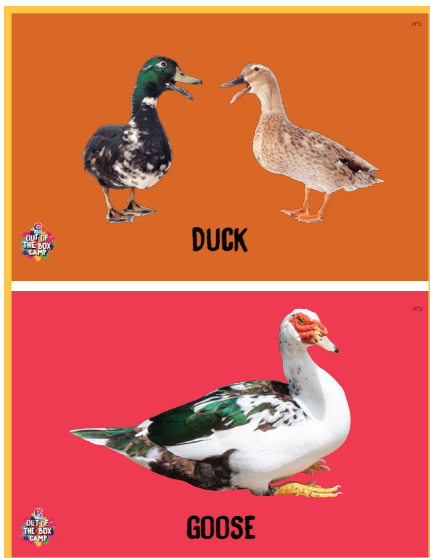

Kosher Animal Corner

 15 Minutes

Setup:

Before you begin, have your parent or counselor cut the Kosher animal cards in half, and tape them onto the walls around the area where you will be playing. The cards should be hung slightly above eye level, and spread at least a few feet apart from one another.



Instructions:

1. Turn on the music track and start exercising or dancing!
2. When the music stops, you must freeze in place.
3. The recording will call out the name of an animal, and if that animal is Kosher, you will have to run to its picture hanging on the wall. If the animal called out is not Kosher, you mustn't move a muscle!
4. If you
 - Accidentally start moving when a non-Kosher animal is called, or
 - Run towards the wrong animal picture, or
 - Run to the correct Kosher animal picture, but another player got there firstYou will have to stand frozen in place for the next round of music, and when the next animal is called you will have a chance to redeem yourself.
5. Try to make it through the most rounds possible before the game is over!



Think About It

Kosher animals have split hooves, and chew their cud. Kosher fish have fins, and scales, and the Torah tells us which birds are Kosher.
