

## Suncatcher

 15 Minutes

### Instructions:

1. Pour a generous amount of glue into your plastic lid and swish it around to cover the entire inner surface.
2. Put one or two drops of each color of food coloring around the glue.



3. Use a toothpick to swirl the colors around in the glue.

**Tip:** Stop swirling before the colors get too combined or the final result will be muddy and brown.



4. Let dry. As the colors settle they will continue to expand and create a tie-dyed effect. Depending on how much glue you used, the suncatcher will take one to three days to fully dry. You will know it's ready when the edges start to peel off the lid.



5. When fully dry, peel the suncatcher off the lid, punch a hole through the top, add a string, and hang in a sunny spot!



### OVERVIEW

Make your own suncatcher by adding swirls of color to glue!

### SUPPLIES NEEDED

- White liquid glue (lots of it!)
- Food Coloring or Liquid Watercolors
- Toothpicks
- Plastic lid (*Lids from tubs of yogurt, hummus, sour cream etc. work best, although metal lids also work*)
- Hole Puncher
- String
