

## Shabbat Time Chalkboard

 15 Minutes



### Instructions:

1. Paint the wooden Hebrew letters of the word Shabbat, שבת, and set them aside to dry.
2. While your letters are drying, use your markers to color in the Shabbat Candle Image. Then, cut out the Shabbat Candles and glue them onto the lower side of your chalkboard.
3. Glue gems, or any other decorative items, along the frame of your chalkboard.
4. Glue your painted “Shabbat” letters onto the top of your chalkboard.
5. Find out the time Shabbat starts this week, and write it with chalk on your board. Don’t forget to update the time every week!
6. Hang your Shabbat Time Chalkboard in a place that will remind your family what time Shabbat begins!

### OVERVIEW

We light Shabbat candles every Friday 18 minutes before sunset. It’s important to know when Shabbat starts each week, so we can light on time! Fill in the weekly time of Shabbat early in the week, so all week long you can look forward to this special Mitzvah!
