

Stain Glass Vase

 20 Minutes



Instructions:

1. Prepare a flat, clean area to work. Put down an empty shopping bag, garbage bag or newspaper to protect the surface area before setting down your supplies.
2. Cut or tear a bunch of pieces of tissue paper. You can make them as big or small as you'd like. You can choose to cut one shape or many different kinds.
3. Paint an area of your jar or bottle with the Mod Podge and start sticking on tissue paper pieces.



4. Work your way around the entire vase, painting and sticking, until the entire outside is covered in tissue paper.
5. Optional: Add some glitter to your mod podge before painting a full coat over the entire vase.
6. Paint a full coat of Mod Podge over the top of your tissue paper, covering the entire vase.



7. Carefully place the vase in a safe place to dry for at least 24 hours.
